Improvement of Native Women's Centre Accessibility

Hamilton, Ont. - The Hamilton-Wentworth Chapter of Native Women's Centre Incorporated would like to announce that honouring the Circle, located at 21 Rosedene Ave., and has been approved for funding through the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program <http://www.feddevontario.gc.ca/eic/site/723.nsf/eng/h_02195.html> for accessibility improvements.

Construction will commence immediately on the North – west entrance of 21 Rosedene Ave. These structural improvements are to ensure community members as well as any and all staff that may need or require utilising the accessibility lift will be able access 21 Rosedene Ave as required.

Moving forward, as construction commences MVP and HTC will continue with all regular work schedules. There will be no temporary entrance to this location as the current doors will not be affected by the constructional improvements.
